TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 44 held on Tuesday 7TH March, 2017

CTC LEAF: 27,988 packages and 11 packages of New Season Teas on offer met with a good demand.

BROKENS: A select few clean liquoring teas on offer met with a good demand and were firm to slightly dearer. Medium and plain varieties were again an easier market with fair withdrawals. Poor types once again met with a fairly good enquiry but were slightly easier. There were some withdrawals in this category.

FANNINGS: A small weight of clean liquoring Fannings on offer met with a good demand and were generally firm. Plain and Medium types were also a fairly good market but were mostly easier with some withdrawals. Poor varieties met with a little more interest but were easier with some withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 6,088 packages of teas on offer met with a fairly good demand. Good liquoring teas were firm

to slightly dearer. Medium varieties were an easier market with fair withdrawals. However, plain end of season teas met with more demand and sold between Tk.95/- and Tk.120/-. Loose tea buyers were fairly active with fair support from the Blenders.

COMMENTS Both Blenders and Loose Tea buyers lent a good support for all varieties on offer. However, withdrawals particularly in the plainer category continued to be quite high. Pakistan buyers once again operated at lower levels.

Dusts sold well.
