## TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 45 held on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2017

CTC LEAF 10,507 packages and 249 packages of New Season teas on offer met with strong demand at higher rates.

**BROKENS:** All Brokens met with a strong demand and generally appreciated by Tk.10/- to Tk.15/- except for the poorest which advanced by Tk.5/-.

**FANNINGS:** Here again, there was a strong demand and prices mostly advanced by Tk.10/- to Tk.15/- particularly for the cleaner lines on offer which advanced further. The poor varieties on offer appreciated by Tk.5/- to Tk.10/-.

**CTC DUST:** 2,140 packages and 9 packages of New Season teas on offer met with a fairly strong demand.

All teas met with more competition and were dearer by Tk.5/- to Tk.10/-. Loose tea buyers were active for all types whilst there was less interest from the Blenders.

**COMMENTS** This was the pen-ultimate sale where buyers participated strongly particularly the Loose tea section of the market. Blenders also operated strongly for a few clean teas on offer. The Pakistan buyer was more active at the lower end of the market. As a result, withdrawals were negligible.

Dusts were a dearer market.

The major blender was active with fair support from the exporters and the regional packeteers. TGBL and the internal market were selective.
